Financial Donations

- Make sure all gifts for Camp Widjiitiwin are clearly marked for camp.
- Online donation through Canada Helps secure site ([CLICK HERE](#)) and designate your gift to Camp Widjiitiwin. You can even set it up for regular or monthly giving.
- Cheques may be sent to Camp Widjiitiwin, Box 10020, Huntsville, ON P1H 2K1.
- Cash can be donated through the MBC office.
- Canadian Tire money can be mailed to camp or dropped off in the jar in the Bookstore at MBC. Canadian Tire money will be used mostly to purchase sports equipment and some tools.
- People and places to give to:
 1. Adopt a cabin for \$250 and you will be providing for their cleaning supplies, a new smoke detector, a working fire extinguisher, a fan, a weekly special treat (i.e.: pizza party or ice cream social), etc.
 2. Camper sponsorships can be in any amount. Camp fees range from \$450.00 for TNT to \$1250.00 for SALT. Monthly that works out to just \$37.50 to send a TNT camper to camp for a week, \$39.60 for a Blast or Sizzle camper and \$104.17 for a SALTer
 3. Pay for a summer staff's honorarium, which range from \$500 for a first year summer staff up to \$2,500 for a senior summer staff.
 4. Renovate a cabin for \$1000 – roof, soffit, fascia, etc.

GIFTS IN KIND

We are primarily looking for new items to ensure quality, but if you have gently used items in great condition we would appreciate those as well. Items we are looking for include, but are not limited to:
